Construction Notice – Southbound Lane Closure on 111 Street During Off-Peak Hours

Beginning **on/around July 21**, Ledcor will temporarily close one southbound lane on 111 Street across the Blackmud Creek traffic bridge. This is necessary to create access for future construction of the Blackmud Creek LRT bridge. The southbound lane closure is expected to last approximately two weeks.

To help with traffic flow, work is scheduled during non-peak hours from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. on weekdays only. The southbound lane will reopen outside of the active work hours.

Other Impacts

- Southbound traffic will be merged to one southbound lane on 111 Street between 19 Avenue and 12 Avenue.
- <u>Pedestrians and cyclists will be moved to a temporary detour on the east side of the</u> <u>Blackmud Creek bridge.</u>
- Efforts will be made to minimize noise, vibration and dust. Mitigation measures will be implemented to monitor and reduce these impacts.
