

Construction Notice – Traffic Shift on 111 Street (Phase 1)

Beginning **on/around May 10**, Ledcor, the Design-Build contractor for the project, will shift traffic on 111 Street between Anthony Henday Drive and Blackmud Creek. Traffic will be shifted to the west side of 111 Street, so Ledcor can build a new permanent roadway on the east side of 111 Street (to make room for the LRT tracks on the west side). The shift will occur in multiple phases, with Phase 1 lasting approximately **two months**.

Traffic on 111 Street will continue to have two lanes in each direction for roughly four weeks. In late May/early June, northbound traffic on 111 Street at 9 Avenue will be reduced to one lane for roughly three weeks. A separate notice will be sent to remind residents of this lane closure. For the duration of the work, **some turning lanes, sidewalks and bus stops will be closed** within the construction areas. Speed limits will be reduced to 40 km/hr.

What to Expect

Traffic Impacts

- The **dedicated left turn lanes on 111 Street at 12 Avenue and 9 Avenue will be closed, although left turns will still be allowed.**
- The **dedicated right turn lane on northbound 111 Street heading east onto 12 Avenue will be closed, although right turns will still be allowed.**
- Traffic on 9 Avenue will be shifted to the north section of the roadway on both sides of 111 Street. One lane will be open eastbound and westbound.
- No parking will be permitted on 9 Avenue in the construction areas.
- For safety, the speed limit in the work zone on 111 Street will be reduced to 40 km/h in each direction.

Pedestrian Closures

- The sidewalk south of 12 Avenue, east of 111 Street, will be closed. Pedestrians can cross 12 Avenue on the west side of 111 Street or at Running Creek Road/110B Street.
- The sidewalk north of 9 Avenue, east of 111 Street, will be closed. Pedestrians can cross 9 Avenue on the west side of 111 Street or at Running Creek Lane.

Bus Stop Closure

- The northbound bus stop on 111 Street at 9 Avenue will be closed.
- Southbound bus stops on 111 Street will not be affected during construction.

Other Impacts

- Work will occur on weekdays and occasionally on weekends between 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.
- Efforts will be made to minimize noise, vibration and dust. Mitigation measures will be implemented to monitor and reduce these impacts.
