### **50 Street over Whitemud Drive Bridge Rehabilitation**

Rehabilitation of the 50 Street Bridge over Whitemud Drive is scheduled to begin in early April 2025. Rehabilitation of the bridge will ensure a safe and reliable crossing for all modes of travel for the next 25 years. Construction is anticipated to be completed in 2026.

#### **Construction Details**

- Bridge deck renewal.
- Upgraded pedestrian and traffic barriers.
- Additional miscellaneous bridge repairs.
- Remove and replace asphalt pavement at each intersection of the bridge.

#### **Traffic Impacts**

- Traffic flow on Whitemud Drive will be maintained, though single-lane closures may occur outside peak hours (i.e. outside of 6–9 a.m. and 3:30–6:30 p.m., Monday to Friday).
- 50 Street Bridge work will require reduced lanes northbound and southbound.
- Whitemud Drive on-ramps and off-ramps will be reduced to one lane for the duration of the project.
- Some night work will take place to minimize disruptions.

#### Access

- Access to businesses and nearby residential properties will be maintained at all times.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout construction with reduced sidewalk widths.
- Access to the ETS bus stops will be maintained.
- Alternative routes are available via 66 Street, 34 Street, and Roper Road, both east and west to 75 Street and 34 Street.

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- 1 50 Street to Whitemud Drive westbound on-ramp one lane (inside) closed
- 2 50 Street over Whitemud Drive three (3) northbound lanes & two (2) southbound lanes open
- Whitemud Drive eastbound off-ramp to 50 Street one lane (inside left turn) closed
- 4 Whitemud Drive eastbound off-ramp to 50 Street one single thru lane open
- 5 Whitemud Drive westbound off-ramp to 50 Street one single thru lane open

- 6 Whitemud Drive westbound off-ramp to 50 Street one lane (inside left turn) closed
- Pedestrian sidwalk open at all times with work zone detours
- 8 Whitemud Drive eastbound and westbound open below bridge during peak hours with reduced lanes during off-peak hours
- 9 50 Street to Whitemud Drive eastbound on-ramp one lane (inside) closed
