Construction Notice

99 Street Underground Pedway Project

In 2025, the City's contractor, Ledcor, will continue construction on the 99 Street underground pedway from Churchill LRT Station to the <u>Station Lands</u> development north of 104 Avenue.


Sections of 99 Street, between 102A and 103A Avenue, will continue to be closed to vehicle traffic, with wayfinding signage in place to help pedestrians and cyclists navigate the area (images below). The City Hall Parkade is accessible via 103A Avenue, but is anticipated to flip to 102A Avenue in fall 2025. While work progresses, periodic closures to the existing pedway system may be required. Pedway construction is anticipated to be complete in 2026.

What to expect in 2025:

- Continuation of underground pedway construction, including electrical/mechanical services and installation of architectural finishes where structural sections are complete.
- Construction will start on the pop-up entrance north of 103A Avenue in the green space near the CN Tower bus loop.
- Excavation and drilling will occur next to 99 Street and 103A Avenue for construction of the final tunnel segment.
- Sections of 99 Street and 103A Avenue will continue to be closed to vehicle traffic.
- Wayfinding signage is posted to help pedestrians, cyclists and motorists navigate detours near the construction site.
- Every effort will be made to minimize dust and noise and reduce impacts to the public during festivals and events near the construction site.




