



Construction Notice – Anthony Henday Drive North Access Road Construction

Beginning **on/around April 7**, Ledcor, the Design-Build contractor for the project, will begin constructing an access road just north of the future Anthony Henday Drive LRT bridge. The access road will be built at the southwest corner of 9 Avenue and 111 Street. Southbound traffic on 111 Street will be reduced to one lane south of 9 Avenue during off-peak hours, between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m on weekdays and occasionally on the weekend. This work is expected to last approximately one week. Please refer to the maps below for details about **upcoming lane and sidewalk closures**.

What to Expect

- Work will occur on weekdays and occasionally on the weekend between 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.
- Southbound traffic on 111 Street will be **reduced to one lane** south of 9 Avenue **during off-peak hours** (between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.)
- No parking will be permitted within the work zone.
- The sidewalk on the south side of 9 Avenue will be closed west of 111 Street. All other pedestrian access near the intersection will remain open.
- Efforts will be made to minimize noise, vibration and dust. Mitigation measures will be implemented to monitor and reduce these impacts.
