Construction Notice – Berm removal along 111 Street

Beginning **the week of December 9**, Ledcor, the Design-Build contractor for the project, will begin removing the berm on the west side of 111 Street, between 23 Avenue and Saddleback Road/19 Avenue. Crews will start near 23 Avenue and progress south.

- This work is anticipated to take approximately two months.
- Work will occur on weekdays and Saturdays between 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.
- Truck traffic will increase, but no other traffic disruptions are expected.
- Pedestrian access remains closed on the west side of 111 Street between 23 Avenue and Saddleback Road/19 Avenue.

During berm removal, the top layer of soil will be removed using heavy machinery. The area will then be levelled to accommodate the LRT trackbed and an entrance for the LRT underpass at 23 Avenue and 111 Street. Efforts will be made to minimize noise, vibration and dust. Mitigation measures will be implemented to monitor and reduce these impacts. Once project construction is complete, trees and native vegetation will be planted along the alignment as part of the final landscaping plan.
