

Construction Notice – Tree removals along 111 Street

Beginning on/around **January 13**, Ledcor, the Design-Build contractor for the project, will need to remove approximately 50 trees on 111 Street between 12 Avenue and 9 Avenue. This work is expected to last approximately one week and is necessary to prepare for the eventual shifting of 111 Street to make room for the LRT. Please refer to the map below for details.



Beginning on/around **February 3**, Ledcor will need to remove an additional 50 trees on 111 Street between Saddleback Road/19 Avenue and 12 Avenue. This work is also expected to last approximately one week. Please refer to the map below for details.



Other Impacts

- Work will occur on weekdays between 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.
- Pedestrians using paths or sidewalks adjacent to work zones may be temporarily stopped to accommodate equipment and workers.
- No traffic disruptions are expected during the work.
- Efforts will be made to minimize noise, vibration and dust. Mitigation measures will be implemented to monitor and reduce these impacts.

In accordance with the municipal [Public Tree Bylaw](#), all tree removals will be conducted under the supervision of certified arborists. Ledcor acknowledges Edmontonians are passionate about trees and have a desire to maintain the city's extensive urban canopy. The decision to remove a tree is never taken lightly. Once project construction is complete, new vegetation including trees, native grassland, shrubs and flowers will be planted along portions of the alignment.
