
CSWB Community Collaboration Model (CCM)

Composed of individuals interested in governance and providing advice on the operation of the CCM and its spaces

City Project Team

The City will provide administrative, reporting, information coordination, hosting/convening, evaluatory and communications support

Discovery & Development Space

In this Space we will focus on learning that leads to action, problem solving and continuous improvement. A priority will be gathering, sharing and mobilizing assets, lived experience and community knowledge.
