

Refrigeration Mechanic I

DEFINITION

This is journeyman level work in the refrigeration and air-conditioning trade.

An employee of this class will be involved in the construction, repair and maintenance of air conditioning and refrigeration units.

Assignments are received in the form of oral and written instructions, accompanied by sketches and blue-prints. The work is subject to inspection in progress and upon completion.

TYPICAL DUTIES*

Performs preventative maintenance on all refrigeration and air conditioning units.

Checks and installs controls for air conditioning and refrigeration units.

Installs new air conditioning and refrigeration units as required.

Changes and alters existing refrigeration and air conditioning units as required.

Trouble shoots air conditioning and refrigeration units.

Performs other related duties as required.

KNOWLEDGE, ABILITIES AND SKILLS

Considerable knowledge of the standard methods, practices, materials, tools and equipment used in the air conditioning and refrigeration trade.

Knowledge concerning the rules and codes controlling refrigeration and air conditioning trade.

Knowledge of the occupational hazards and safety precautions of the trade.

Familiarity with the work of related trades such as plumbing and gas fitting.

Sufficient strength to perform medium work requiring cutting, bending and joining pipes of various sizes.

Good visibility in locating leaks in refrigeration and air conditioning lines.

Ability to manipulate a variety of hand and power tools related to the work.
