Benefit plan changes

Your Alberta Blue Cross® benefit plan has changed retroactively to March 1, 2024. You will find a summary of what these changes are below.

PRESCRIPTION DRUG PLAN CHANGES

DIABETIC SUPPLIES

Current coverage

Eligible expenses for the purchase of select prescribed diabetic supplies include lancets, alcohol swabs and urine and blood glucose testing strips for the monitoring and treatment of diabetes.

What is changing?

Glucose monitoring systems are now covered under your prescription drug benefit plan at 80%. Reasonable limits and a requirement of a written order from a health care professional will apply.

Eligible systems under your plan include, but are not limited to, Dexcom G7 and Freestyle Libre. To minimize out-of-pocket expenses, ask your pharmacist to directly submit your claims to Alberta Blue Cross.

Additional information

For claims for eligible glucose monitoring systems, with a service date between **March 1, 2024**, **and December 31, 2024**, the following must be submitted for consideration:

- 1. Paid in full receipt
- 2. Written prescription from a health care professional

Submissions must be made to Alberta Blue Cross no later than **April 30, 2025**.
