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## **Commercial Building - Partial Final Inspection**

This inspection is conducted **by request only** and, when passed, will produce a **partial occupancy** document. A <u>final inspection</u> is required after passing this inspection.

## **Prepare**

Learn about how to prepare for your inspection.

The work must meet all the applicable codes and standards.

## Check

Pre-final documents including C-schedules for the areas to be inspected have been submitted in <u>selfserve.edmonton.ca</u> and reviewed. Allow for a <b>minimum of 2 business days</b> for the review to be
completed. Review the Commercial Building Inspections page for more information.
Key plan identifies areas to be inspected
An operational and updated Construction Fire Safety Plan must be in place. Review the Construction
Site Fire Safety Plan page for more information.
If life safety devices (fire alarm and sprinkler systems) are not operational, a fire watch approved by Fire
Rescue Services must be in place.

The following are the most common items audited during this inspection. However, the list is not exhaustive.
