

EDMONTON COMBATIVE SPORTS COMMISSION FINAL MEETING MINUTES

May 9, 2022 7:00 PM Online via Google Meet

1. Call to Order and Land Acknowledgement

The meeting was called to order by Acting Chair, Trevor Kelly, at 7:03 pm., Monday, May 9, 2022.

The Edmonton Combative Sports Commission acknowledged the traditional land on which we reside is Treaty 6 Territory. 3. Call for Requests to Speak from the Public

4. Adopt Agenda

7. Stakeholder Engagement Working Group Update

A. Lam provided an update on the scope of work for stakeholder engagement. A request was made to increase the budget by \$1,850 to accommodate two 90-minute in-person engagement sessions. T. Courtoreille will confirm that there are no issues with increasing the budget and bring forward the motion to the next meeting making sure it is not outside of the procurement process. The Commission will look at holding these sessions at Commonwealth Stadium on June 9, and 16, from 7:00 pm until 8:30 pm with 8 to 10 people per session.

G. Smith will provide stakeholder key messages to the Commission for review.

D. O'Callaghan, G. Smith, and K. Malahy will meet with A. Lam for a 45-minute pre-engagement session.

Training for event officials was a success and there is a possibility of scheduling another session in the fall.

The Executive Director position has been posted.

T. Courtoreille is meeting with Law and the Branch Manager of Community Standards and Neighbourhoods this week regarding the status of combative sports in Edmonton. The Deputy City Manager is recommending a discussion about the need for a provincial commission.

The Executive Director will find out what he can share with the Commission regarding the pending lawsuit and report back.

MOVED: That the written report from the Executive Director be accepted as presented.

10. Financial Statement

Honoraria are the only expense on the March statement.

The status of the \$10,000 paid back to the City is still unknown. T. Courtoreille is looking into it and hopes to have an update for the June meeting.

MOVED: That the March 31, 2022, Financial Statement be approved as presented. CARRIED

D. O'Callaghan will connect with N. Seecharan about Commission orientation.

T. Kelly and D. O'Callahan presented the Annual Report to City Council on April 27, 2022.

A. LeMoine offered to provide a space to hold the Commission retreat from 9:00 am until 4:00 pm on June 26, 2022. The \$3,500 cost will be put forward for approval at the next meeting. The Work Plan will be included on the agenda for the retreat.
