Arc, the Edmonton region's electronic fare payment system, is a convenient and flexible way to pay for transit.

All senior fare riders, including monthly and annual pass holders, are now using Arc. Seniors who receive ETS Subsidized Senior Annual Passes will no longer receive an ETS paper or plastic pass. ETS will provide seniors with Arc cards preloaded with the reduced price annual pass.

Using Arc:

Tap your Arc card on the fare validator when you get on the bus or enter the proof of payment area in an LRT station. Tap it again when you exit the bus or proof of payment area at an LRT station.

If you travel with Dedicated Accessible Transit Service (DATS), you can tap on and off using the driver's Arc handheld fare validator.

The 2025 Subsidized Annual Pass on your Arc card is valid on ETS buses and LRT only.

You can use your Arc card to travel on other transit agencies in the Edmonton area by adding money to your card to pay the fare set by the agency. Visit myarc.ca/features/fare-rates to learn more.
