Surveys

- + An online survey was available to the public from February 13 to March 3, 2024

In-person drop-in event

- + An in-person drop-in event occurred on February 22, 2024, at the Ritchie Community League Hall
- + Participants were encouraged to ask questions and provide feedback through interactive posters or maps
- + The event included project information and asked:
 - + What are the community's favorite things about 76 Avenue
 - + What are the community's challenges regarding 76 Avenue
 - + What improvements could be made to 76 Avenue
 - + What the community's ideas are to improve driving, biking, walking and public gathering spaces on 76 Avenue
