The City of Edmonton is building a low-rise apartment building at 9418 83 Street that will be used for supportive housing.

Edmonton



Supportive housing is a type of affordable housing that combines below-market rents with on-site health and social support services. Residents are selected to ensure the services offered on site meet their needs. They sign a lease, pay rent and create a permanent home for themselves. **Supportive housing is critical infrastructure that will help prevent and end homelessness in Edmonton.** The City is leading construction of new supportive housing in Holyrood. On-site work will begin this fall and be completed by the end of 2024. When construction is complete, the building's ownership will be transferred to Homeward Trust. Homeward Trust will select an experienced non-profit organization to run the supportive housing program.
