

How to Download CRA Eligibility Documents

Step 1

Google CRA my account and select "My Account for Individuals - Canada.ca"


Step 2

If you sign in through your bank, select "Sign-In Partner".

If you already have your User ID and password, select "CRA sign in".

If you do not already have your User ID and password, select "CRA register".

If you have a MyAlberta Digital ID and password, select "Provincial partner sign in".


