2.	Confirmation of agenda		
	The agenda was adopted as circulated.

	The minutes of the previous meeting were accepted as circulated.		
4.	Status of action items (none)		
5.	Project Update & Discussion		
	City of Edmonton representatives reviewed recent and upcoming activities. Highlights included: The removal of buildings on properties acquired by the City is continuing. Construction is well underway on the temporary transit centre at West Edmonton Mall. There is ongoing utility relocation work by EPCOR Communications and outreach activities have ramped up, with information being shared with affected areas and groups via email, social media and the project website. The information centre has been fielding numerous calls, and information postcards have been delivered to more than 60,000 homes. An updated project booklet has been posted online, and outreach to local businesses will continue throughout the summer. There is also a new web page devoted to helping area residents, businesses, road users and pedestrians prepare for LRT-related construction. Marigold Infrastructure Partners (MIP) shared an update on current and future work. The summary included: Designing and planning the work is well underway. Geotechnical drilling has been completed. Some of the early work includes beginning on the elevated guideway near the Misericordia Hospital and West Edmonton Mall. Sewer-related work is expected to begin in the fall near Meadowlark. The plan is to close the Stony Plain Road bridge over Groat Road in 2023 for replacement. Every effort will be made to minimize traffic disruption. MIP will keep neighbourhoods informed of upcoming activities in a variety of ways including bulletins, door hangers, postcards and		

	meetings with local organizations. MIP will also be launching its own construction-related website in the near future [post-meeting note: website address is https://marigoldinfra.ca], and questions regarding construction plans can be directed to MIP at public@marigoldinfra.ca . MIP will be establishing a site office and laydown area at 156 Street at 95 Avenue. Also providing parking for crews, the area will be fenced.		
7.	Round Table		
	 There was a suggestion from the group that community art might be considered where construction hoarding is required, similar to an initiative for the Valley Line Southeast in the downtown area.
