Changes to ETS Route 612 Affecting Archbishop O'Leary, St. Cecilia and Queen Elizabeth Schools

In response to changing ridership, route 612 will be rerouted through the Mayliewan, Ozerna, Matt Berry and Hollick-Kenyon neighbourhoods and will no longer stop at 95 Street and 132 Avenue (Queen Elizabeth School).

We apologize for any inconvenience this route change may cause. However, the area around Archbishop O'Leary, St. Cecilia and Queen Elizabeth Schools continues to be served by several regular service ETS routes, including routes 610, 613, 614, 624, 625 and 626.

Frequently Asked Questions

How do I find out which new route to take?

You can easily find your route by using the trip planner at <u>edmonton.ca/Transit</u>, or Google Maps' "public transport" option.

Can I still use my school board Arc card?

You can still use your school-issued Arc card—and benefit from the reduced fare cap—on regular service buses and LRT. Be considerate! Help make everyone's ride safe and comfortable.
