Changes to ETS Route 621 Affecting Londonderry School

Due to low ridership, the route 621 trip departing 66 Street and 178 Avenue at 7:53 a.m. will be cancelled as of the end of June 2025. For an updated route brochure, please visit <u>edmonton.ca/SchoolSpecialBusRoutes</u> in August.

Route 621 will continue to run twice in the morning and twice in the afternoon, with an extra trip (for a total of four trips) on Thursdays.

Frequently Asked Questions

How does ETS decide which trips get cancelled?

ETS takes a data-driven approach to putting resources where they are needed most. Service changes are made based on data like on-time performance, rider numbers and crowding.

How do I find out which new route to take?

You can easily find your route by using the trip planner at <u>edmonton.ca/Transit</u>, or Google Maps' "public transport" option.

Can I still use my school board Arc card?

You can still use your school-issued Arc card—and benefit from the reduced fare cap—on regular service buses and LRT. Be considerate! Help make everyone's ride safe and comfortable.

- Your backpack doesn't need a seat.
- Move to the back of the bus and make room for others.
- Let riders exit the bus before boarding.
- Keep your feet off the seats.
- Wear headphones or earbuds when using your phone.

Taking transit is environmental action. One full bus can eliminate up to 50 cars from the road, reducing emissions and traffic congestion.
