Changes to ETS Route 675 Affecting S. Bruce Smith School

Due to low ridership, route 675 to S. Bruce Smith School will be cancelled as of the end of June 2025. We apologize for any inconvenience this route cancellation may cause.

Frequently Asked Questions

How does ETS decide which routes get cancelled?

ETS takes a data-driven approach to putting resources where they are needed most. Service changes are made based on data like on-time performance, rider numbers and crowding.

Can I still use my school board Arc card?

You can still use your school-issued Arc card—and benefit from the reduced fare cap—on regular service buses and LRT. Use the trip planner at edmonton.ca/Transit to find your route.

How much does On Demand Transit cost?
