

Rundle Park Trail Renewal

February 2025

The Rundle Park Trail Renewal project will be starting in the spring of 2025. The City of Edmonton will reconstruct six kilometres of shared use asphalt pathways, replace signage and complete naturalization and tree planting.

Construction schedule

Construction is set to begin in May 2025, with completion anticipated for late fall 2025.

Closures and detours

The park will remain open during construction with trail detours and accommodations. The project plans to maintain general access to all on-site facilities. City teams are working with event planners to ensure events can continue during construction, if possible.

Tree removals

The removal of five trees and several small brush strips next to the trails are necessary to complete this work. This work is planned to begin before the end of February. The project will add 17 new trees and several naturalization beds.

The City values every single tree, and removals are guided by the City's Corporate Tree Policy C456C and Public Tree Bylaw 18825, which prioritize the preservation and protection of trees by ensuring equitable compensation for the canopy loss. All trees will be examined for possible impacts to wildlife before removal.
