


Dear Neighbour

We are writing to provide an update on the City of Edmonton-owned land located at 11215 - 106 Street.

As you may recall, this property was previously part of the City's Missing Middle Design Competition in 2018/19, however, the successful developer was not able to move forward with its project. In August 2024, the site was rezoned to Medium Scale Residential Zone (RM h16), which allows for a building of up to 16 meters or about five storeys.

The City now intends to use this site for supportive housing. Supportive housing is a type of affordable housing that offers below-market rents as well as 24/7 wraparound support. Residents pay subsidized rent while receiving support with life skills, and support services for health and wellness. To learn more about supportive housing, visit edmonton.ca/WelcomeHomes.
