Due to significant growth in southwest Edmonton, this vital corridor exceeded its capacity causing congestion, delays, increased collisions, as well as the reduction in speed and

The corridor does not accommodate active transportation,

To accommodate current and future needs, the City is constructing an integrated expansion plan for Terwillegar Drive



Terwillegar Drive Expansion: Program Purpose

- Help achieve the outcomes of the City Plan to accommodate a population of 2 million

- **2017:** Concept planning study begins
- **2018:** Council approval of the expressway plan
- 2019/20: Funding approval from City and Province
- **2021:** Construction on Stage One begins
- **2022:** Construction on Stage One continues

Construction Impacts on Traffic

Vehicle Traffic

- Additional construction and major traffic impacts will begin on Whitemud Drive in early 2024.



Roadworks will require staged shoulder and lane closures along the Whitemud Drive and Terwillegar Drive corridors

Pedestrian and Cyclist Traffic

- Pedestrian and cyclist pathway connectivity will be maintained throughout the project
 - Active modes users will be detoured through the Whitemud Creek ravine temporarily while the new shared-use path bridge is being constructed

- Access to Snow Valley and the Rainbow Valley Campground will be maintained
- Traffic will be monitored, and adjustments will be implemented where possible to improve traffic flow through the project area

- The current pedestrian sidewalk on the Westbound Rainbow Valley Bridge will be closed and replaced by the new Rainbow Valley shared-use path bridge (2024)
- The 142 Street Pedestrian/ Cyclist bridge will cross Whitemud Drive and provide a connection between Brookside and Brookview at 142 Street. Completion is anticipated in 2025.



Overall Traffic Impacts 2024 – 2026

On Whitemud Drive, two lanes will remain open in each direction during peak hours. There will be impacts to traffic

The westbound Rainbow Valley Bridge will close in Early 2024. Two-way traffic will be moved onto eastbound Rainbow Valley

The eastbound Rainbow Valley Bridge will close in 2025. Two-way traffic will be moved onto westbound Rainbow



Rainbow Valley Bridge Rehabilitation and Widening

- The bridges, constructed in 1979 and 1982, are due for their first major rehabilitation
- The bridges will be widened to four lanes plus shoulders
- Sidewalk will be removed and new pedestrian bridge constructed
- Construction site compounds will be located in Rainbow Valley

Vehicular Traffic: Major Traffic Disruptions

Rehabilitation and widening of the Rainbow Valley Bridges will be phased:

2024: Closure of Westbound Rainbow Valley Bridge, two-way traffic established on Eastbound Whitemud Drive (Early 2024)



2025: Closure of Eastbound Rainbow Valley Bridge, two-way traffic established on Westbound Whitemud Drive (Early 2025)

Active Transportation: Shared Use Path Upgrades



• Construction of a shared-use path started in 2023 with the path reconstructed near 122 Street. The remainder of the path will be constructed in 2024

Upgrades to the existing shared-use path between 122 Street and 142 Street

• A fence or similar barrier between Whitemud Drive and the path for the safety of cyclists and pedestrians will be constructed in 2024



Transit Upgrades: Bus-Only Lane

Construction includes:

- Retaining wall construction in 2024
- Bus-only signals at 53 Avenue west ramp intersection
- Segregated bus-only lane from 53 Avenue to Terwillegar Drive is anticipated to be complete in 2025

Whitemud Drive Widening and Upgrades

Whitemud Drive will be widened to four lanes in each direction between Terwillegar Drive and 122 Street

Retaining Walls Ongoing – 2024

Five retaining walls are needed for roadway widenings and the bus only lane:

Noise Attenuation

Noise assessment was conducted. Noise attenuation is considered when noise levels in private residential backyards exceed 65 dBA

- A noise barrier will be constructed in Ramsay Heights
- Engagement with residents backing onto the wall is ongoing
- Works are anticipated to begin in late 2024

Stage One: Construction

Construction began in 2020 and is anticipated to be complete in 2024

Two vehicle travel lanes will be open in each direction during peak hours until the end of 2023

Stage One North: Rabbit Hill Road to Whitemud Drive

- Widening between Whitemud Drive and Rabbit Hill Road was completed in 2022
- Landscaping including soil placement, tree replacements, new boulevard trees on cross streets and the addition of naturalized grasses along the corridor is complete

Stage One South: Anthony Henday Drive to Rabbit Hill Road

- Widening between Haddow Drive and 23 Avenue is ongoing and connections to the new Haddow Drive and 23 Avenue intersections have been pre-graded. Roadway construction in this area is to be completed in 2024
