Playgrounds are a crucial part of Edmonton's neighbourhoods. Playgrounds foster play and encourage social interaction, exploration and imagination for residents of all ages. The City of Edmonton is renewing the playground in Tipton Park to ensure it is accessible for all.

Project overview

As part of the renewal, the City will replace the existing play equipment. A rendering of the preferred equipment is available on the project web page. New landscaping will include sod and shrubs, a new picnic table, benches and garbage cans.

Construction impacts

Construction is expected to start in July and be complete in the fall of 2025. The park area north of the pathway and spray park will remain open during construction. Access to the spray park will be available from the southwest corner of the park.

No tree removals are planned as part of this project.

Residents in the neighbourhood may experience increased noise levels and traffic around the area. All construction will take place during the hours of 7 a.m. to 9 p.m. Monday to Saturday, according to the Community Standards Bylaw. Construction equipment and materials will be stored near the work area.
