DEFINITION

Employees of this class operate and are responsible for a truck, auxiliary equipment and trailer combination where the combined Alberta licensed gross vehicle weight exceeds 13 600 kg (30 000 lbs). Incumbents in this position are responsible for providing long-haul transfer of material for the Edmonton Waste Management Branch to various landfill and recycling facilities both inside and outside the city limits. Assignments also include performing routine labouring work and incidental clerical work. In addition, incumbents may be expected to perform routine maintenance on either the truck or equipment located at the work site.

TYPICAL DUTIES*

Hooking and unhooking tractor trailer units up to twenty (20) times per day and pick-up and delivery of tractor-trailer units from various locations.

Operate a tractor trailer unit on pavement and muddy conditions at landfills and other disposal sites.

Process loads inbound and outbound either over the scales on site or through the bypass lanes.

Performs routine maintenance and servicing duties such as; cleaning and sweeping of truck tunnels, washing tractor, trailers or other onsite equipment as required.

Ensure all aspects of the daily operations on and off site are carried out in an environmentally and safe manner.

Transport Grinder unit for Roadways Maintenance (this is a price up for Roadways for this specific duty only).

Performs related work as required.

KNOWLEDGE, ABILITIES AND SKILLS

Ability to drive a truck rated in the designated weight range.

Ability to understand and execute oral and written instructions.

Knowledge of Waste Management Bylaw and other legal requirements of the position.

Physical strength and agility sufficient to perform work of this class.

TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS

Job Level

Completion of the twelfth (12) school grade supplemented by two (2) years experience in the operation of tractor-trailer units or equivalent combination of training and experience. Possession of a valid Alberta Class one (1) motor vehicle operator's license, City Driver's Permit and airbrake certification.
