Coverage	Benefit Description
History	<ul> <li>Formed in 1941</li> <li>Originally called the Civic Employees Welfare Chest Fund</li> <li>Name of Fund changed in 1945 to ECECAF</li> </ul>
Membership	<ul> <li>Consists of 9 unions and associations - ATU569, CEMA, CEP 829, CUPE 30, IBEW 1007, EFFU 209, Association of Management and Non-Union Affiliates, United Nurses of Alberta 196, Edmonton Senior Police Officers' Association</li> <li>Over 11,000 participating members</li> </ul>
Board of Trustees	<ul> <li>Comprised of a representative from each of the participating unions/associations</li> <li>Allocates funds in accordance with established criteria and guidelines</li> </ul>
Funding	<ul> <li>Employees contributions are ¼ of 1% of annual salary</li> <li>60% of the contribution is allocated to the charitable portion of the fund</li> <li>40% of the contribution is allocated to the educational portion of the fund</li> <li>Employees must contribute for a minimum of 12 consecutive months prior to receiving a scholarship for their dependent</li> </ul>
Charitable Portion	<ul> <li>Provides Special Aid funding to members with financial hardship because of a requirement for medical services/equipment due a severe health condition.</li> </ul>
Educational Portion	<ul> <li>Provides scholarships to members' dependents for post-secondary education</li> </ul>
Participation	<ul> <li>Management and Out-of-Scope employees have only <u>ONE</u> chance to opt in or out</li> <li>Unions are mandatory</li> </ul>
