Eastwood/Elmwood Park Neighbourhood Renewal

The Eastwood/Elmwood Park Neighbourhood Renewal project team organized the following opportunities for the public to help refine the project team's understanding of the improvements needed and confirm the draft vision and guiding principles. Additional emails and phone calls from community members received by the Project Manager will also be considered along with the overall feedback.

Survey



- ▶ An online survey was available for the public to complete from February 19 to March 4, 2019. The survey presented specific design options and features to help understand community preferences before incorporating them into a draft plan.

Workshops



- ▶ Two public workshops were held on May 1 and May 4, 2019 at the Eastwood Community League.
- ▶ Display boards presented the design options for specific areas around the neighbourhoods, as well as the benefits and tradeoffs of each option.
- ▶ Attendees completed a workbook to provide comments and identify their level of support for each option. There were over 1600 pages of input!

An expanded report on what we heard and what we considered to refine the design options will be released in Fall 2019. The report will be online and printed copies will be available at the next public engagement event in the Fall.
