What We Heard Report: Baturyn Neighbourhood Renewal

Background

Neighbourhood Renewal in Baturyn will begin in spring 2023. Through the City of Edmonton's Building Great Neighbourhoods and Open Spaces Branch, the Neighbourhood Renewal Program will rehabilitate roads, replace street lights, curb and gutters, repair sidewalks and connect missing sidewalk links where possible. Alley Renewal will also be included as part of this project and involves alley reconstruction and repaving, improvements to surface drainage where possible and upgrading of existing lighting to LED fixtures.

Cost sharing opportunities will be made available through the Local Improvement process for sidewalk reconstruction and decorative street light upgrades in the neighbourhood. Other opportunities to improve City-owned parks and public spaces will also be explored.

Public Engagement Spectrum

Starting the Conversation



What we asked

In order to start the conversation with the community, we invited members of the public and stakeholders to **ADVISE** on the most appropriate engagement and communication approaches for the Baturyn community members.



Survey

- We released an online survey available to the public from September 14 to October 4, 2020.
- + We asked for public input on the best engagement and communication methods for Baturyn.

67 participants



Community Conversations

- + We engaged with stakeholders in the area to learn about the most appropriate engagement and communication approaches in Baturyn.
- + We discussed ways to work together to communicate information throughout the project.
- + We asked questions to learn more about key characteristics of the Baturyn community and the best ways to reach certain members of the community including seniors and youth.

What we heard

Key Insights

- + Castle News is an important communications channel for community members in Baturyn.
- Other ways that people in Baturyn share and learn about information include the Community League website and social media channels, school bulletins and websites, posters in local businesses and through local recreation facilities (i.e., YMCA, Edmonton Public Library, Castle Downs Recreation Centre).
- + Many community members prefer online surveys and online tools for engagement.
- Communicating and engaging with certain community members (i.e., youth and seniors) could be possible through collaboration with local facilities and clubs that provide services to these groups.
