- + Neighbourhood Renewal is delivered in coordination with other City departments and projects in the area
- + Through coordination we can also improve other elements including intersection safety, pedestrian and bike connections, and park and City-owned green spaces

What's included

Infrastructure upgrades:

- + Regrading and paving of local and collector roads*
- + Replacing sidewalks**
- + Replacing street lights
- + Construct new sidewalks, where missing

*Necessary utility work is coordinated prior to renewal construction

**Subject to sidewalk or decorative light local improvements

Other potential elements:

- + Implementing connections that help people move (walk, bike, drive)
- + Making improvements to City-owned green spaces (trees, furniture, beautification)
- + Mitigating neighbourhood traffic issues
- + Upgrading to decorative street lights**

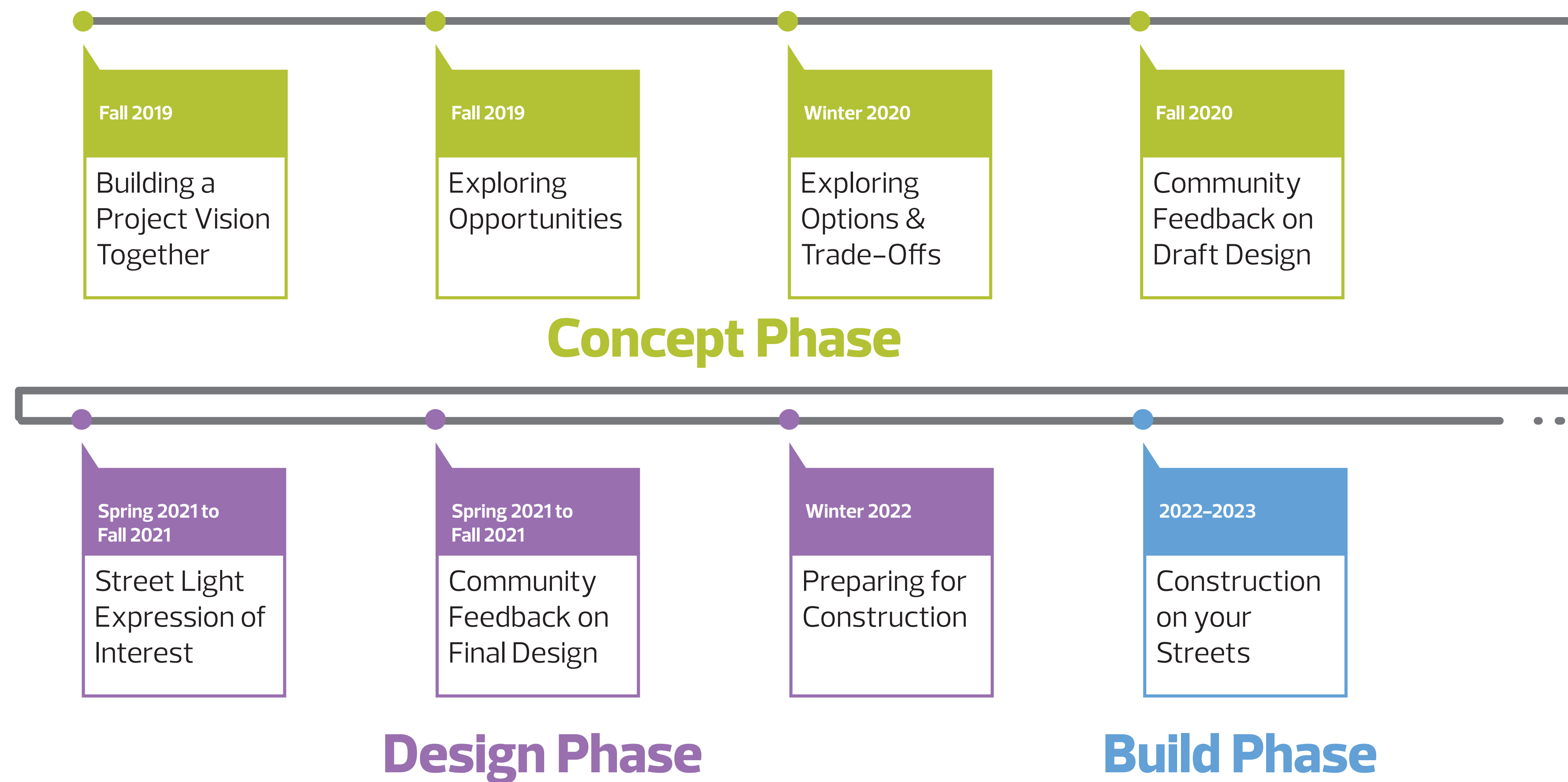

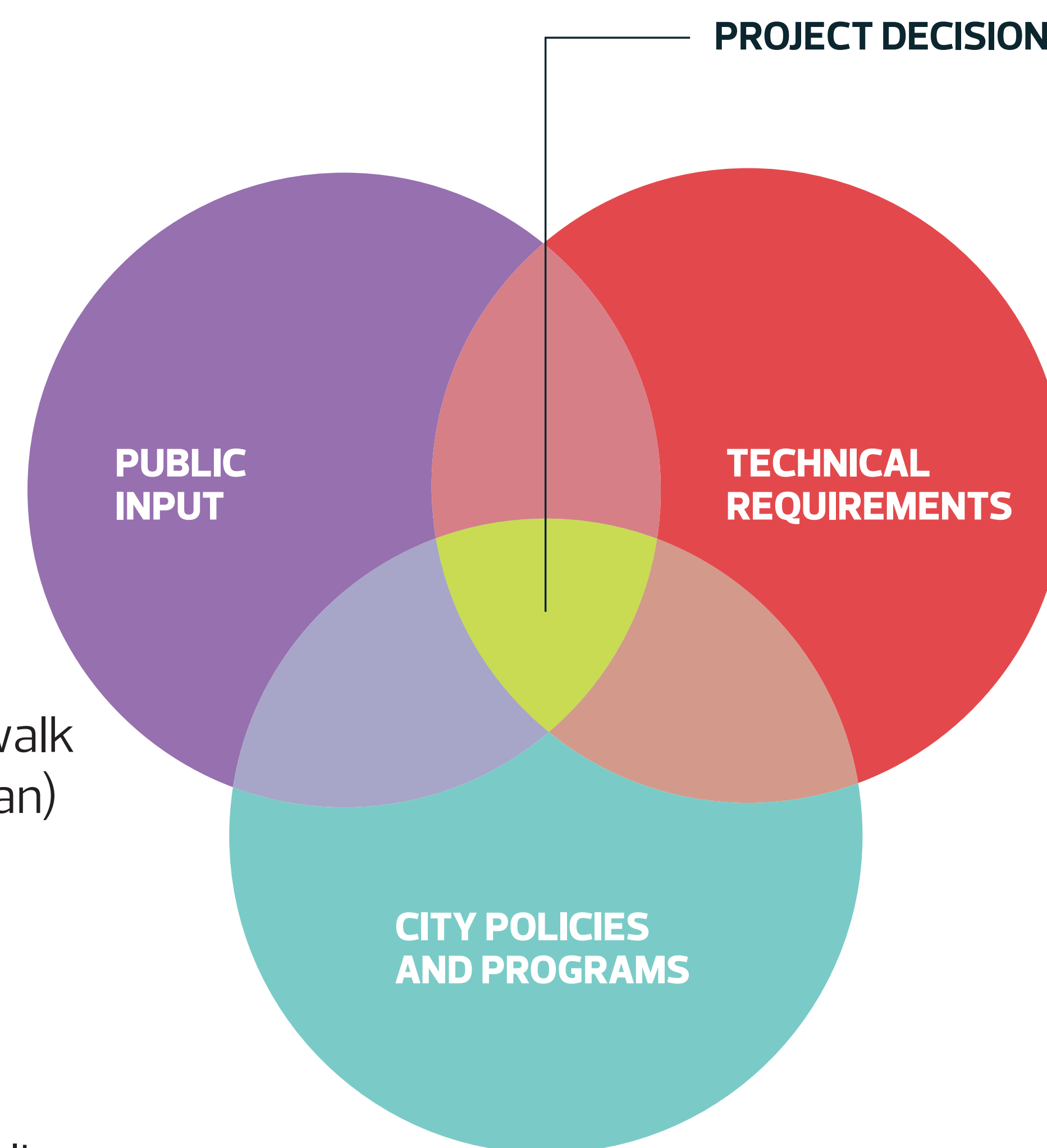
How Decisions are Made

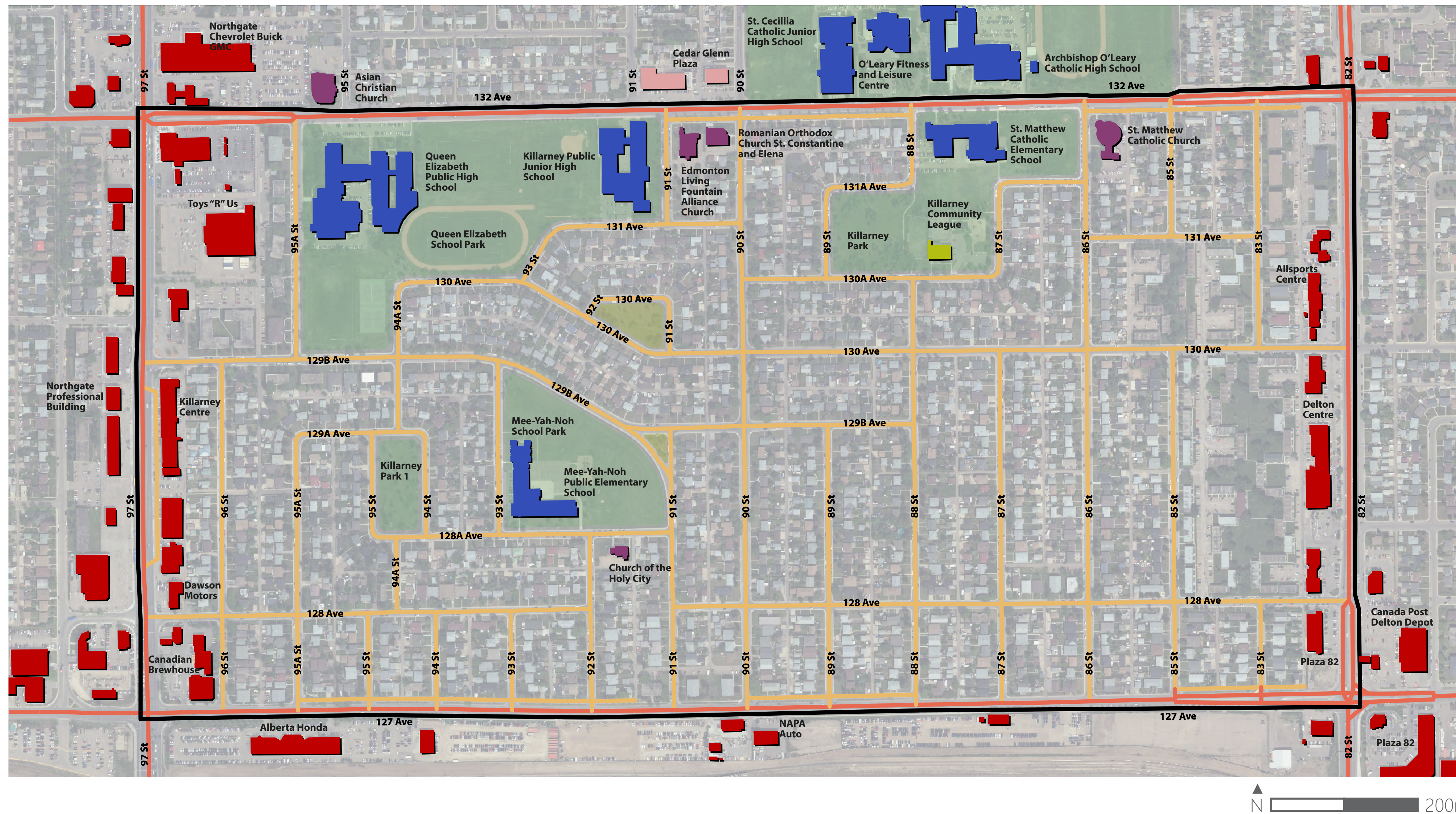
