

Glen's Form

Pear Tree

The Glen's Form is a small to medium deciduous pear tree. The tree is very tolerant and typically grows in an upright columnar shape. In the early spring, the Glen's Form is one of the first to bloom. It produces large amounts of white flowers, and the fruit, though inedible, attracts all types of wildlife. In the autumn, the foliage turns to outstanding colours.








