## City of Edmonton Amusement Ride Parkland Regulations

Prior to having any amusement rides assembled and operated on City of Edmonton Parkland, the following guidelines must be reviewed and adhered to. The goal of these regulations is to ensure public safety as well as the integrity of City of Edmonton Parkland, facilities, and equipment.

- All amusement rides must be assembled, disassembled, inspected, and operated in accordance with Alberta Elevating Devices and Amusement Rides Safety Association (AEDARSA) regulations. Proof of inspection is required by the City of Edmonton prior to operating all amusement rides.
- Absolutely no overnight camping is permitted on City of Edmonton Parkland.
- Support vehicles parked on City of Edmonton Parkland are prohibited without prior authorization. Any parked vehicles will require a City of Edmonton Parking Permit. This permit will be issued to the festival or event organization at the discretion of the City of Edmonton Festival and Events Liaison and will need to be clearly displayed on the vehicle. Parking passes are non-transferable.
- User groups that obtain the services of amusement ride operators are responsible for any damages to City of Edmonton Parkland, facilities, and equipment caused by the assembly, disassembly, and operation of amusement rides.
- Any amusement rides operating on City of Edmonton Parkland must adhere to all environmental regulations and must pose no risk to the environment. Any fuel spills must be contained, reported and cleaned up (at the cost of the user group responsible for contracting the services of the amusement ride operator). To report a spill, please call Alberta Environment at 1-800-222-6514.
- Operation of amusement rides must adhere to City of Edmonton Noise Bylaws including Community Standards Bylaw 14600 and Parkland Bylaw 2202.
- Any amusement ride operator must be fully licensed and insured. It is the responsibility of the festival or event organization obtaining the services of an amusement ride operator to ensure that this is complete.
- Operation of amusement rides on City of Edmonton Parkland will not exceed normal parkland hours unless permission has been obtained from the City of Edmonton.
