Boyle Street and McCauley Neighbourhood Renewal

- + **Enhanced shared roadway (also known as Bike boulevard):** A bikeway that is located on the street and shared with low-volume, low-speed motor vehicle traffic. This design includes speed and volume management techniques to ensure the space is suitable for all ages and abilities.
- + **Shared roadway:** Roadway shared by those who bike, roll and drive.
- + **Protected bike lane:** An all ages and abilities bikeway that is on-street, separated and protected from nearby motor vehicle traffic using horizontal and/or vertical delineators.
- + **Shared pathway:** A type of all ages and abilities bikeway that is off-street and shared by people who walk, roll and bike.
- + **Missing link:** Identified routes that are missing from the bike network, that connect to an existing bike route on one or both ends.
- + **Shared street (Pedestrian-oriented alley):** An alley that is designed as a shared street to prioritize people walking, while still permitting people who drive and bike to use the space at low volumes and speeds. It may include visual cues such as signage or physical cues such as special paving to alert drivers that they are entering a shared space.
- + **Low Impact Development (LID):** LID is a land development and stormwater management approach that works with nature to manage stormwater locally on site. This may include facilities like rain gardens, bioswales, and box planters.
- + **Road right of way:** Road right of way is public land designated for traffic, utilities and people walking, biking and rolling. You can obtain a license for temporary use of road right of way.
- + **Draft Design:** Concept level plan for "what" we will build, including roadway and sidewalk widths, traffic movements, facilities for people walking, biking and rolling, as well as green space ideas.
- + **Preliminary Design:** Plan includes specific design elements such as materials, exact geometry for roadway and sidewalk changes, locations and trade-offs for new sidewalks, and confirms construction schedule and budget. Only minor suggestions and tweaks can be incorporated into the design at this stage.
- + **Gender-based analysis plus (GBA+):** A process of examining how diverse people experience policies, programs and initiatives differently.
- + **Statutory Plan:** A document that has been adopted by City Council as a Bylaw. Statutory plans must be considered when planning and development officers exercise discretion in the decision making process.
