

The Emerging Immigrant and Refugee Community (EIRC) Grant Program contributes to Edmonton's City Plan - #4 Big City move of being an Inclusive and Compassionate city. The EIRC grant exists to support grassroots immigrant and refugee communities who are in the process of settling and integrating.




Figure 1: Total Number of Funded Program and Total Funding Awarded

In 2023, 53 unique organizations received EIRC funding and delivered 63 programs/services to over 4,861 people of all ages. Figure 1 provides a summary of the total number of funded programs for each funding stream and funding allocated. Some examples of the types of programs/services funded included: social support, afterschool/summer programs, employment/entrepreneurial support, cultural support and capacity-building support.
