

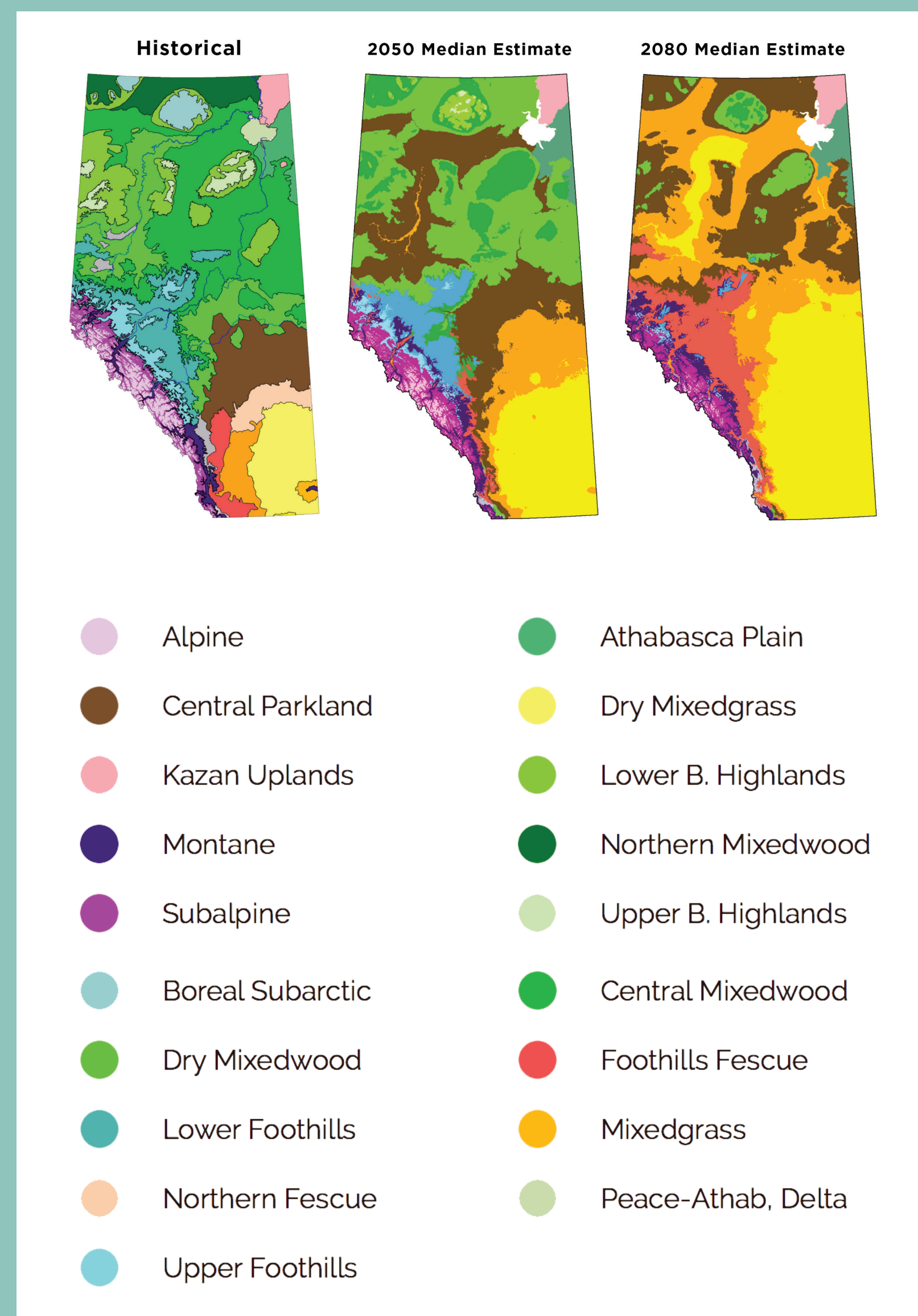
# ECOSYSTEM SHIFT

Historically, Edmonton's ecosystem has been part of the Boreal/Parkland transition zone made up of different types of trees and woody shrubs as well as rich forest floor. In the future, as temperatures and moisture levels change, Edmonton's ecosystem is expected to

be more like the grasslands of Southern Alberta. This change will have an impact on the types of plants and animals we currently see in Edmonton. Some will be able to respond and adapt, some will not.
