Gentlemen:


Re Street Numbering.

be used hereafter, radiating from First Street and  
Jasper Avenue?
3. That <sup>part</sup> ~~half~~ numerically and <sup>part</sup> ~~half~~ alphabetically arranged  
names be used, radiating from First Street and Jasper  
Avenue, with small numbers in centre of the City.
