STATEMENT

The City of Edmonton (the “City”) has established the structure, oversight and processes that support decision-making to ensure that the City’s information and technology investments bring value to the corporation, provide overall organizational and information and technology strategic alignment.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this directive is to clarify responsibility and establish procedures for information and technology investment and architecture of all business systems, information, applications, technology and/or processes.

APPLICATION

This directive applies to all City departments reporting to the City Manager, and all City employees, including fulltime, part-time, temporary and provisional employees and persons acting on behalf of the City such as contractors or consultants. This also applies to all employees in the Office of the City Auditor.
