Statement

The purpose of this policy is to establish a clear and transparent process to utilize the City's land assets as a key tool to facilitate the provision of long-term affordable housing in Edmonton.

Guiding Principles

- 1. City of Edmonton land assets are a resource for enabling affordable housing development The City will annually identify suitable City land assets for proposed sale or lease at less than market value to non-profit organizations for the purpose of affordable housing development.
- **2. Affordable housing is accessible** The City will promote the development of affordable housing in neighbourhoods throughout the City by contributing land assets.
- **3.** The City of Edmonton promotes long-term affordable housing The City will promote the long-term development and availability of affordable housing by ensuring that affordable housing development is supported by an appropriate sale agreement, lease agreement, and/or affordable housing agreement, including the registration of caveats or other instruments on title.
