 Goods Movement

Policy Statement:

Recognizing the importance of goods movement for the quality of life, competitiveness and growth of our city and region, the City of Edmonton will provide a safe and efficient network for goods movement that incorporates an integrated multimodal and regional approach.

The network of key goods movement corridors, truck routes and dangerous goods routes will provide direct, connected, and efficient roadway access for goods movement, balanced with the needs of communities. Through planning, operations and maintenance, the City will prioritize investments in support of a goods movement, with consideration for environmental and social impacts.

The purpose of this policy is to:

Guide transportation, funding and land use decisions to enhance the efficiency and safety of goods movement in the City of Edmonton within a regional context.
