TITLE:	EMPLOYEE DRESS CODE		

Policy Statement:

EACH CIVIC DEPARTMENT AND CORPORATE OFFICE SHALL ESTABLISH A DRESS CODE WHICH SHALL:

- 1. COMPLY WITH CITY AND/OR DEPARTMENTAL HEALTH AND SAFETY REGULATIONS AND BE WITHIN THE SCOPE OF THE ALBERTA OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT AND REGULATIONS OR OTHER LEGISLATED REGULATIONS.
- 2. ENSURE THAT EMPLOYEES HAVING ACCESS TO THE PUBLIC WILL DRESS AT ALL TIMES TO PRESENT AN ACCEPTABLE IMAGE OF THE CIVIC SERVICE.
- 3. INCLUDE DRESS FOR IDENTIFICATION OF EMPLOYEES AS REQUIRED.

The purpose of this policy is to:

Ensure that employees' clothing is suitable for the conditions and the work being performed, with due regard for personal safety, the need for identification as a Civic employee, and presentation of an acceptable image of the Civic Service to the public as identified by individual departmental requirements.
