Heritage Planners' Report Report to Edmonton Historical Board Wednesday May 28, 2014

- Gives me great pleasure to introduce you to our summer student Connor Thompson. He's a
 history student from U of A and he just joined us two weeks ago. He will be working on the
 Church Street "interpretation" project as well as helping us with reviewing best practices on
 tax incentives for heritage.
- David Holdsworth will be taking 3 months leave of absence. He departs for the UK on June 4th and he will be back on September 2.
- Scott will stay on with us for the next 11 months as our Heritage Planner 1.
- We expect to hear soon from the Province about our funding application to prepare a proposed Historic Resources Inventory for the Calder Neighbourhood.
- Bylaws to designate the Bramen Residence and Beverly Cenotaph are scheduled for City Council approval on July 16th.
- Other potential designations still on the horizon include the Molson's Brewery, Mountafield (house in Oliver), Captain John Hall Residence (Cromdale), Cameron Block on 97th Street, Crawford Block (Strathcona) and the McDougall Church.
- We were successful in getting another Young Canada Works grant of \$10, 000 to subsidize the salary of a Graduate Heritage Planner for 8 months. The posting closes this Friday and hopefully we will have a graduate working with us by the 3rd week of June.
- The EHB Annual Report to Community Services has generated an inquiry from City Council to our Department to respond to the following questions:
 - That Administration prepare a report in response to the first four recommendations outlined in the letter from the Chair in the 2013 Edmonton Historical Board report, including:
 - 1. Information on process
 - 2. How we could move forward
 - 3. Possible prioritization of the recommendations

This report is scheduled for Executive Committee in the fall of 2014.
