### **DATS Advisory Group Update**

- DATS is now offering some new services to clients. Upcoming trips booked under client's cell
  number are sent automatically by text message in reply to texting the letter "D" to DATS. Clients will
  have the option to be placed on a waiting list if they request a ride and the schedule is full for that
  day, instead of having to keep calling back.
- Some DATS clients currently have up to twelve subscription trips scheduled in one week. One
  option being considered to manage this is to limit to one subscription trip per client during peak
  times. Cancellations on subscription trips are not permitted. Subscription will be cancelled if a trip is
  cancelled. A cap on the number of bookable subscription trips has been suggested, but the
  maximum number has not yet been determined.
- DATS is funded to provide around 900,000 total trips per year with each trip provided subtracted from that total. Each person on the bus, even if they are all going from the same pick up point to the same drop off point is counted as a separate trip.
