Draft ETSAB Response to ETS Proposed Transit Fare Policy

- The draft report in response to ETS Proposed Transit Fare Policy recommends that Administration consider introducing a second tier of qualification for seniors' discounts to make it compatible with the Ride Transit program, that Administration consider introducing a 50% fare reduction for seniors who use the system during off-peak times, and that Administration consider introducing a 3 day pass, at between two and two and a half times the cost of a daily maximum fare.
- Members were in favour of approving the report with no changes, and the Chair plans to present it to the Urban Planning Committee at their October 15, 2019 meeting to coincide with Administration's report CR_7078 - ETS Fare Policy.
