112 Avenue Bridge over Wayne Gretzky Drive Rehabilitation

The City of Edmonton will rehabilitate the 112 Avenue Bridge over Wayne Gretzky Drive to extend the bridge's service life and ensure the continued safety of all users. Rehabilitation work will address deteriorated bridge elements and include the addition of a new shared pathway to the northside of the bridge. **Construction is expected to begin in April and be completed in 2027.**

Construction details

- Removal and replacement of deteriorated concrete on the bridge
- Roadwork adjacent to the bridge
- Deteriorated underdeck bridge elements removal and replacement
- Rehabilitation is expected to take two construction seasons
- Construction will be paused through the winter months to help maintain traffic flow and accessibility
- Construction will be completed in phases to maintain traffic flow where possible. During each phase, traffic will be shifted to one side of the bridge while rehabilitation work is underway on the other

Access

- During construction, 112 Avenue will be reduced to one through lane and one turning lane in each direction on the bridge. Lane configurations may change as work progresses
- Temporary lane closures on Wayne Gretzky Drive will be required at times to safely accommodate construction activities. These closures will be short-term and scheduled to minimize impacts as much as possible
- Access for active modes will be maintained on one side of the bridge, with signage and temporary accommodations provided as required
- The City will work to minimize impacts to residents, businesses, and commuters and will provide advance notice of major traffic shifts, lane reductions, or access changes throughout construction
