ELIGIBLE MAINTENANCE WORK

Work Eligible for Maintenance Grant

Proposed maintenance work should be reviewed with the Heritage Planner prior to application for grant monies. A listing of possible work that may be eligible for grant rehabilitation is listed below.

- Exterior cleaning, preparation and painting
- Window repair and restoration
- Repair or replacement of roofs (including cedar shingles)
- Repair/repointing of brickwork or masonry
- Repair and restoration of exterior cladding (siding, stucco, cedar shingle/shakes)
- Structural work (foundations, etc.)
- Engineering or architectural consultant fees

Please note that maintenance work unrelated to the key character-defining elements of the property are not eligible for a Maintenance Grant. Such work may include, but is not limited to: administrative and/or operational costs; permit fees; utilities services and installation costs; privately-owned building/structure relocation; energy retrofitting/upgrading; or installation of new services or amenities such as handicap access, elevators, washrooms, security and fire alarm systems
